Effective Mar. 16, 2020, 5pm - Tentatively 8am, May 4, 2020

The Cultural Activities Center staff and board members are working together to follow all recommended guidelines from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and public health officials in the wake of the warnings regarding flu and COVID-19 (2019 novel coronavirus). In accordance with the latest guidelines, effective Mar. 16, 2020 at 5pm and tentatively ending May 4 at 8am, the Cultural Activities Center is CANCELLING ALL EVENTS AND WILL BE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC. Suggested measures for everyone's personal safety should be observed such as frequent hand washing, covering your face if coughing or sneezing and staying home or away from groups if you feel sick.
